<b>TITLE:</b>	Setting Tyre Pressures In Cold Ambient Temperatures
<b>DOCUMENT NUMBER:</b>	11 T 009
<b>AFFECTED VEHICLES:</b>	All Model Variants
<b>SITUATION:</b>	McLaren Automotive Engineering would like to inform retailers to prevent customers from getting low tyre pressure warning messages, the tyre pressure should be set relevant to the ambient temperature and not to the workshop temperature.
<b>PROCEDURE:</b>	When the temperature inside the workshop at the time of the tyre pressure setting process is higher than the outside ambient condition, you must add 0.1 bar to the recommended tyre pressure (0.1 bar should compensate for a 15 degrees temperature drop, i.e. morning chill).
